Materials

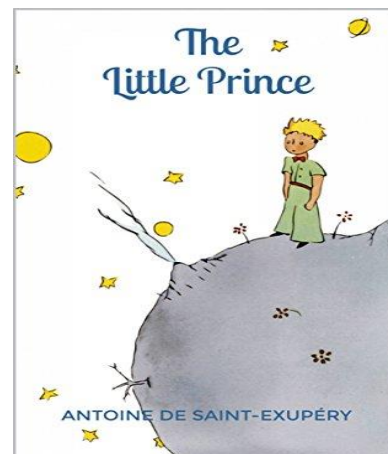
Book: *The Little Prince* by A. de Saint-Exupéry
