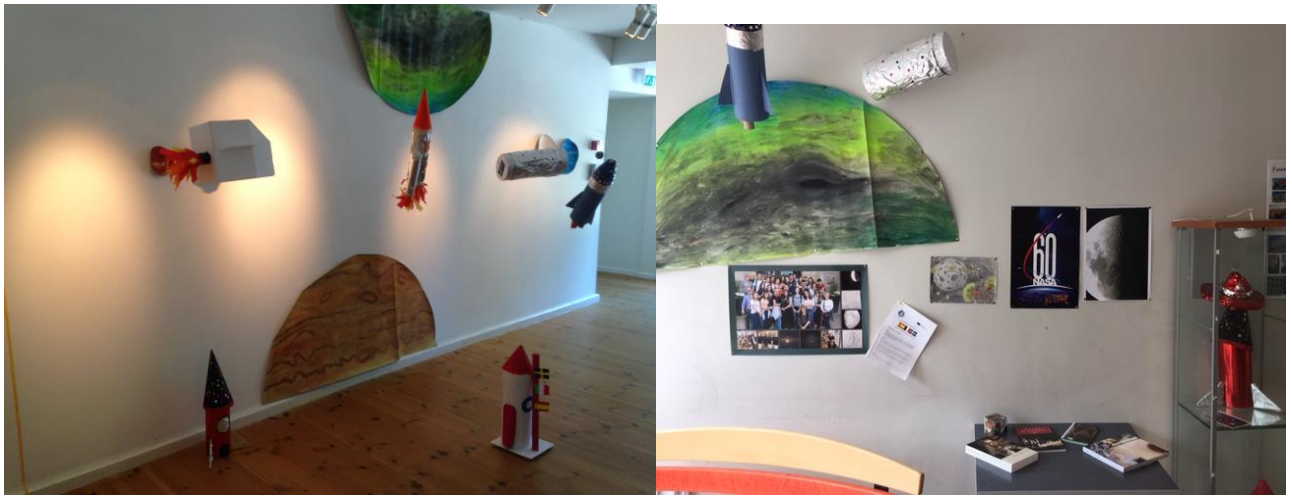
A workshop was held at the Museum of Art in Eskilstuna, where the students were able to combine knowledge and fantasy, to be creative.
